Cookies

What Are Cookies

Cookies are files that Web servers place on an Internet user's computer that are designed to store basic information (such as visitor preferences). The use of cookies on this Website allows visitors to enjoy more seamless visits and more accurately measures visitor behavior on the Website. There are two types of cookies: session and persistent. Session cookies exist only during an Internet user's online session. They disappear from the user's computer when the latter closes the browser software. Persistent cookies remain on the user's computer after the browser has been closed. The cookies used on the Website do not identify you personally. They merely recognize your browser, unless you choose to identify yourself voluntarily. Otherwise you remain anonymous.
